## PRIMARY SERVICES

Southwest Behavioral & Health Services is working to reduce overdose in the community by providing overdose prevention education, resources, and supplies. These services are available to the community with no enrollment required—individuals and organizations can simply contact us to get support.

### Program Goals Include:

- **Help people with active opioid and stimulant use**
- **Make sure care is well-coordinated between treatment, recovery, and prevention services**
- **Support people in recovery so they can stay healthy and stable long-term**
- **Provide education and prevention efforts to reduce drug misuse and harm**
- **Reduce overdose deaths related to opioids and other drugs**
- **Use proven approaches to address substance use problems from prevention through recovery**

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## SUPPLEMENTAL SERVICES\*

- Overdose prevention education, resources, and supplies
- Recovery support
- Navigation into treatment or recovery services as desired, including medication services and recovery homes
- Employment and housing support and resources
- Assistance with resources to meet personal needs

**\*Supplemental Services are available to any adult excluding those with SMI designations (who are able to receive services in another program).**



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
